



Based in Gladstone New Jersey, Doug Payne is well known as the competitor, judge and trainer to turn to whether you are training your horse for competition or trying to remedy a complicated behavioral problem. He has been profiled in and contributed to Practical Horseman, US Eventing and New Jersey Countryside as well as a number of other regional and national publications and media. Along with Jim Wofford, Doug produced the acclaimed 'the Rider's Eye' instructional DVD.

Officially Doug is an USEF 'r' Judge and Technical Delegate. He is also USEA ICP certified instructor. Doug holds a Mechanical Engineering degree from Rochester Institute of Technology, and is also a graduate 'A' pony clubber from Somerset Hills Pony Club.

Doug might be best known in the discipline of Eventing. Doug's winning ways have their roots with a Silver Medal effort in the the North American Young Rider Championships (2000). Since then, Doug has won countless national and international competitions from Beginner Novice through Advanced. In 2010, he had 110 starts with 16 wins and 64 top 5's and 89 top 10 placings on 21 different horses.

In Dressage he has had international success through FEI Intermediaire I. Doug was 5th at the Bengt Lindquist Memorial Championships at Prix St. George (2007). He has been a multiple regional year end award winner at the FEI levels.

2010 was also a very busy year in straight jumping as well. Doug had 32 top 10's, 29 top 5's with 18 wins on the 'A' circuit on 6 horses from level 1 to Grand Prix.
